## **Combined Training**

Class 1: Starters – Open to anyone who hasn't won any dressage apart from Intro or any jumping competition. BD Intro 4 (2024)/ Poles on the ground (penalties given for kicking a pole or refusals!)

Class 2: Beginners - Open to anyone who may have won Intro/Prelim dressage but not won a jumping competition. BD Intro Test 4 (2024) Show jumps approx. 50cm

Class 3: Novice – BD Prelim 1 (2024) Show Jumping approx. 60cm Class 4: Intermediate – BD Prelim 1 (2024) Show Jumping approx. 70cm

Class 5: Open – BD Novice 1 (2024) Show jumping approx. 80-90cm

## Combined Training Entry Fees: Members £20 Non Members £24

### **Dressage Classes**

Class 6 Intro 4 (2024) Class 7 Prelim 1 (2024) Class 8 Novice 1 (2024)

Entry Fees for dressage ONLY: Members £13.50 Non Members £16.50

If you have entered the combined training you will automatically be entered in the dressage class too.

Dressage will be on a surface. All working in is on grass – there is a small indoor school available for dressage warm up if needed. Show Jumping in a large, good quality grass arena. Rosettes to 4<sup>th</sup> place.

Juniors to be 8 yrs old and over and not to have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025.

Seniors to be 18 yrs or over by 1st January 2025.

Times will be given for dressage, Please proceed to the SJ as soon as you can after the dressage. If you wish to jump again after your competitive round, please pay at the ring - £5 per round (bring cash).

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Neither **Delamere Forest Riding Club**, its committee nor any persons acting on its behalf, accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to any person, animal or property whatsoever from whatever cause. Everyone mounted at a DFRC event MUST wear a properly adjusted riding Hat, with chin strap fastened, conforming to a minimum standard of:

- PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) AND BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark
- VG1 01.040 (2014-12) AND BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark
- EN 1384 (2023) AND BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark
- ASTM F1163 (2015 onwards) AND SEI mark
- SNELL E 2016 or 2021 onwards AND Official SNELL label and number
- AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) AND SAI Global mark

Dressage whips (max length 120cm including the lash) & callers are permitted.

Jumping whips/batons must be padded - you will not be allowed to carry any other type of whip for jumping.

No horse may be ridden competitively by more than one rider in the same class. Stallions are not allowed at any DFRC event

All horses must be correctly vaccinated with the last booster within 12 months but not within 7 days of the competition.

**Directions:** From Acton Bridge direction please do not turn up the lane by the Leigh Arms Pub as it is very narrow and a single track road. The better route is to turn right off the A49 at the cross roads with the A533 into Runcorn Road and take the 2nd turn on the right into Little Leigh village. Pass the school on the left, the church on the right and the road bends sharply right in front of Little Leigh village hall. Church Farm is clearly signed 2nd drive on the right after the bend. There will be someone on the yard to oversee the parking.
